Huntington-Ingalls Shipbuilding Looking to Hire 2,500 Workers

MOBILE – The Alabama Career Center is partnering with Huntington-Ingalls Shipbuilding to recruit workers in the skilled marine industry. Huntington-Ingalls plans to hire 2,500 workers over the next two years.

Applicants **MUST** participate in a pre-screening interview at a Career Center in order to be considered for these positions. The deadline to request a pre-screening interview is July 7, 2015. Veterans will receive priority, and ex-offenders are also encouraged to apply.

“This is a great example of business and government working together to improve lives in Alabama,” said Fitzgerald Washington, Commissioner of the Alabama Department of Labor. “These are high paying, skilled jobs that will enhance Mobile’s economy.
