CHAPTER 480-1-4 HEARINGS AND APPEALS

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480-1-4-.12 Filing Of An Appeal.

- (1) A party appealing from a determination of a claims examiner on a claim for unemployment compensation benefits shall file in writing, with the Department of Labor, Industrial Relations Building Hearings and Appeals Division, Montgomery, Alabama 361301 or with a representative of the Department of Labor at a local employment security office, or by telephone to a call center.
- (2) A party contesting in any other matter shall file with the Department of Labor, Industrial Relations Building Hearings and Appeals Division, Montgomery, Alabama 361301 or such other office as may be prescribed by statute or rule or as indicated upon official correspondence.
- (3) If the appeal shall be filed is in writing, it shall state the facts alleged and the grounds upon which a review is sought. Receipt of the appeal within the time prescribed by statute or rule shall constitute filing.
- (4) Call centers will allow the appeal to be filled by telephone if the appealing party personally speaks to Department of Labor personnel. Said appeal will be deemed filed as of the date of that event.
